- Sarah Josepha Hale is referred to as the Godmother of Thanksgiving for urging governors, editors, ministers, and President Lincoln to make Thanksgiving Day a fixed national festival.
- In 1939, pressured by store owners who wanted more shopping days between Thanksgiving and Christmas, President Franklin D. Roosevelt changed Thanksgiving from the fourth to the third Thursday in November. In 1941, it was changed back to the fourth Thursday.
- Turkey became the traditional Thanksgiving fare because at one time it was a rare treat due to its cost.

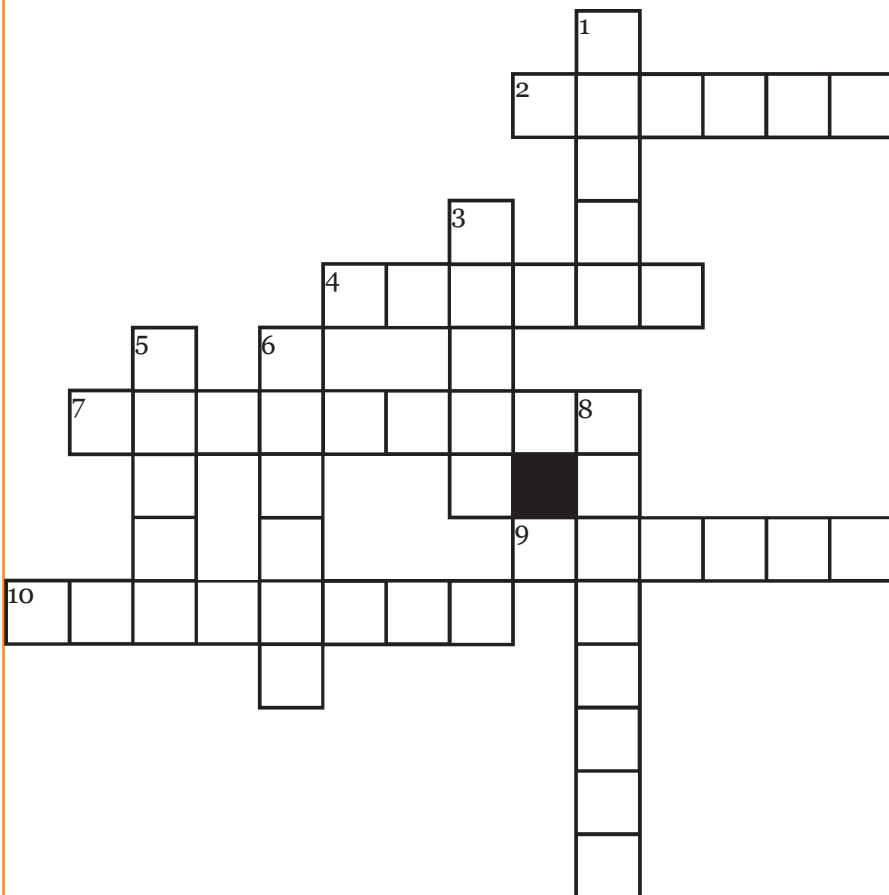

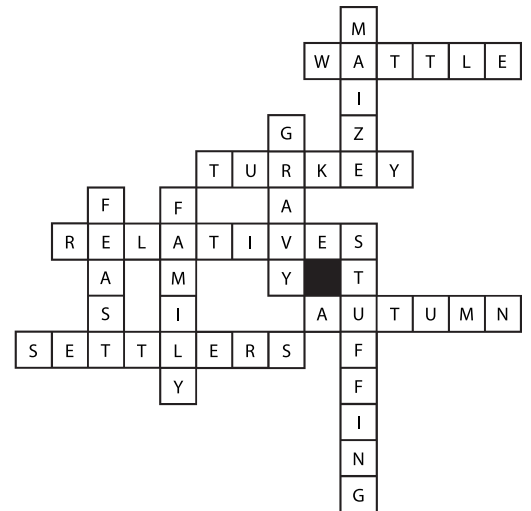
Uzoma Booket
