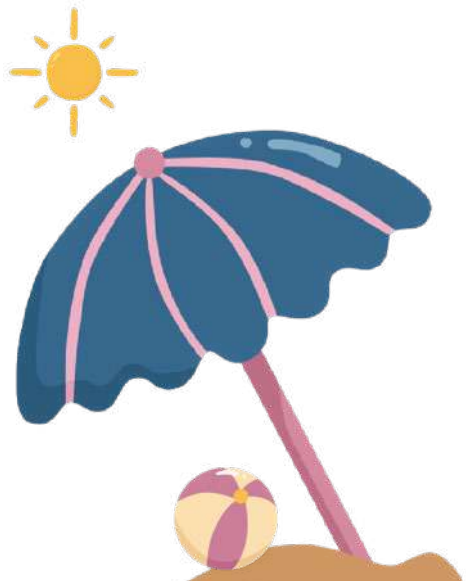

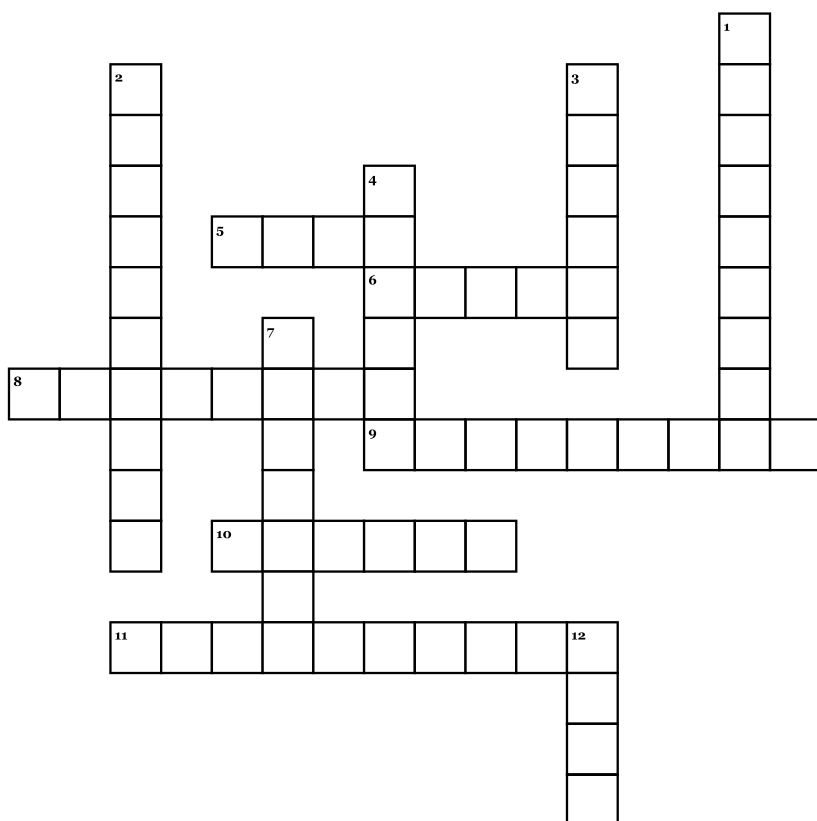

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

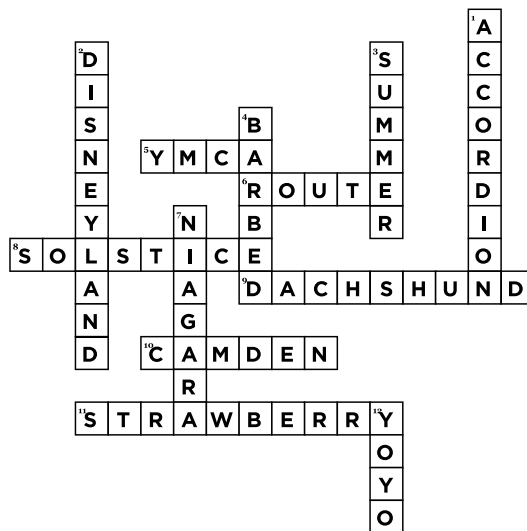
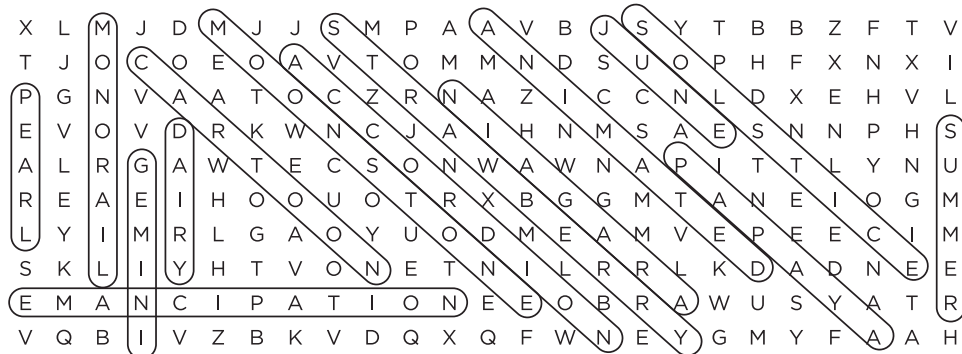
STEPHEN MATHIS
